The introduction of Common Core curriculum in middle and high schools has been a source of confusion for many students and parents. Common Core Math is based on concepts and skills that a student must apply in order to solve real-world math problems. These classes have adopted a style of instruction called "Integrated Math," which describes the technique of mathematics education which integrates multiple strands of math rather than teaching discrete subjects like Algebra, Geometry, and Pre-Calc. In this approach, each math course covers many or all of these topics, presented in real-world contexts with the intent of developing a deeper meaning for mathematics.

The Hamilton Education Bridge series offers introduction, enrichment, and enhancement to the course structures students will encounter as they transition into their high school years (Integrated Math 1 to 3). Twice a week, students will meet with our senior math instructors for 2 hours to receive the skills and guidance they need to boost their performance and confidence in their understanding of math concepts.
